National TrendCare Coordinators Day

Helpful Hints

Hospital Isolation Report

This report is used to:

- Locate all isolated patients in the hospital within the selected report period.
- Enable the infection prevention teams and Duty Managers to identify, and round on, isolated patients
- Ensure that the appropriate isolation type and protocols have been implemented.

Selection options provide:

- Ability to view Day, Evening and Night periods.
- Ward views give additional details.

Hospital Period Patients Selected Conditions Report (New in 3.6.1)

The Conditions Bank is maintained by the site's TrendCare Coordinator in hospital maintenance. COVID isolation can be added as a condition to the list selection. The new report displays all patients assigned to the selected condition for the report period, enabling the tracking of COVID patients.

Workload Allocation

This function, within Allocate Staff screen, enables the shift leader to allocate workloads to an individual and/or staff teams. When staffing by acuity, it is important that there is a fair distribution of clinical hours available between staff, teams, and wards. Consideration should be given to the acuity/care requirements of individual patients, the ward skill mix and the clinical skills of each staff member.
